It really seems as if it were yesterday when, in a small rented room in Banská Bystrica, the designer, engineer, technician, gunsmith, sales manager, and head of logistics were sitting together with the owner and CEO over the first production units of the K100 pistol. The catch is that the room only had one chair.

As a career soldier, Jaroslav had a vision in his head of the perfect service handgun. A weapon which would be reliable, safe, robust, modern, equipped with modern controls, but most importantly, ergonomic and user-friendly.

This is why even the very first K100 pistols were equipped with fully ambidextrous controls, a feature which 20 years later is finally seeing widespread adoption across the firearms industry.

But the gun had another ace up its sleeve, one which would differentiate it from the competition and would allow it to make its mark on the world of firearms design – a rotating barrel.

This feature is now an integral part of GRAND POWER firearms and it is thanks to this solution that lends them a noticeably lower recoil and muzzle flip – factors which go a long way to fulfil the vision of a user-friendly weapon.



During its 20 years of operation GRAND POWER has grown from a rented room into owning two production facilities in Slovenská Ľupča and Kremnické Bane. The jobs which during in the beginnings of the company were performed by one person

The company which in its beginning had one employee now employs over 120 people. Small batches of firearms have turned into shipping containers of several thousand firearms leaving its premises headed for over sixty different countries.

The STRIBOG line has in a few short years steamrolled the American market where it has firmly established itself in a sea of some pretty tough competition and continues to grace the covers of gun magazines around the world.

In the year of its twentieth birthday the company has started producing modern semi-automatic rifles GP R15 and the distinctive GRAND POWER R15 Freya and Freya Skeleton. To cater to the needs of armed forces and law enforcement we have developed a line of select-fire GP M4 rifles as well as a piston driven GP M4M.

Recent legislative changes in Slovakia have also prompted the introduction of a new product line – sound suppressors for a wide range of calibers.




In the last year the world has seen a significant increase in demand for firearms from both civilians as well as military customers. GRAND POWER has a full line of firearms well-suited for use by militaries, law enforcement and security forces. K105 and K102 machine pistols, STRIBOG AP9 and AC9 submachine guns in different configurations, even GP vz.16 heavy machine guns in 12.7x108 and .50BMG. GRAND POWER will be increasing its

production capacities in this segment without forgetting its customers – competitive and recreational shooters, or those who, day after day, count on GP firearms for their safety and the safety of their loved ones. In the very near future, the Mk23 model will bring some muchneeded improvements and more modern features to our portfolio.





Our company has always strived to bring something extra to our customers. To go the extra mile. Not to settle for good enough. This is why we continually strive to improve our products, our production methods, technologies and designs, raising our own bar for quality ever higher. Ninety percent of all components of GRAND POWER firearms are produced at our own production facilities to ensure that all components undergo the highest level of quality control. Individual components undergo QC checks after every machining step with the help of the most modern 3D measuring instruments. Machined parts are then deburred, polished and fitted by hand as necessary. The next quality check is carried out during the assembly of our firearms, where expert gunsmiths check the quality of individual parts and finished firearms. Subsequently, every firearm is subjected to a final QC check which also entails every firearm being test fired for function and accuracy. Every handgun ships with a target showing the grouping shot during this test. The final step before a firearm being released on the market consists of proof testing in an official proof-house.





At GP we believe that only a multi-step QC check can guarantee the highest quality product which customers have come to expect from GRAND POWER.

The heart of GRAND POWER handguns is the so-called insert – a steel container in a polymer grip module machined out of a single piece of steel which holds all of the individual components in one robust unit. All load and pressure bearing components are machined out of solid steel. While this method is costlier and more time consuming, the quality of parts produced this way far outperforms other production methods.
